For it has been told unto me, my brethren, of you, by them that are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you. Was Paul then crucified for you? or were you baptized in the name of Paul? I give God thanks, that I baptized none of you but Crispus and Caius; lest any should say that you were baptized in my name. For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not in wisdom of speech, lest the cross of Christ should be made void. For the word of the cross, to them indeed that perish, is foolishness; but to them that are saved, that is, to us, it is the power of God.

Gospel of Matthew 14:14-22

At that time when Jesus saw a large crowd, out of compassion for them and he cured their sick. Now, when it was evening, his disciples came to him, saying, "This is a desert place and the hour is already late; send the crowds away, so that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food." But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away; you yourselves give them some food." They answered him,

"We have here only five loaves and two fishes." He said to them, "Bring them here to me." And when he had ordered the crowd to recline on the grass, he took the five loaves and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to his disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And all ate and were satisfied; and they gathered up what was left over, twelve baskets full of fragments. PSALM 7

EIGHTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Before the miraculous feeding of five thousand, the Lord's disciples wanted the people to be sent away, but the Lord said to them, They need not depart, give ye them to eat (Matt.14:36). Let us learn this saying, and watch time the enemy suggest to us to refuse someone who asks for something, let us say on behalf of the Lord, They need not depart, give ye them to eat, and let us give them whatever we find at hand. The enemy destroys he desire to offer charity and suggests that perhaps the asker is not worthy of alms. But the Lord did not investigate the worthiness of those who were sitting there. He served everyone equally, while, of course, not everyone was equally devoted to Him. Perhaps even those who later cried, Crucify Him! were there. Such is God's overall Providence for us: He maketh His sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and the unjust (Matt.5:45). If only the Lord would help us even a tiny bit to be merciful, as our Heavenly Father is merciful (cf. Luke 6:36)!
