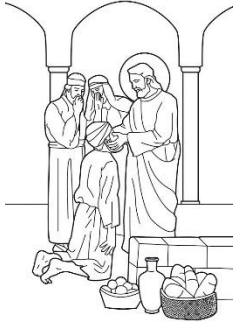

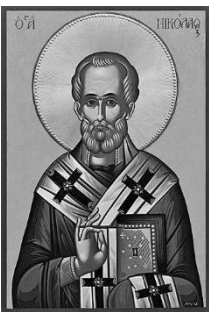

Gospel of Matthew 9:27-35
