A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (2:1-11):



Brethren, when the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. Gospel John 7:37-52 & 8:12



Now on the last, the great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirst, let him come to me and drink. He who believes in me, as the Scripture says, 'From within him there shall flow rivers of living water.'" He said this, however, of the Spirit, whom they who believed in him were to receive; for the Spirit had not yet been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified. Some of the crowd, therefore, when they had heard these words, said, "This is truly the Prophet." Others said, "This is the Christ." Some, however, said, "Can the Christ come from Galilee? Nicodemus, he who had come to him at night, who was one of them, said to them, "Does our Law judge a man unless it first gives him a hearing; and know what he does?" They answered and said to him, "Are you also a Galilean? Search the Scriptures and see that out of Galilee arises no prophet." And again, Jesus spoke to them saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows me does not walk in the darkness but will have the light of life."

Rejoice, O Queen, boast of the virgins and mothers, for every tongue, though capable and eloquent, cannot hymn you as is your due, and every mind is confounded in seeking to comprehend the way in which you gave birth. 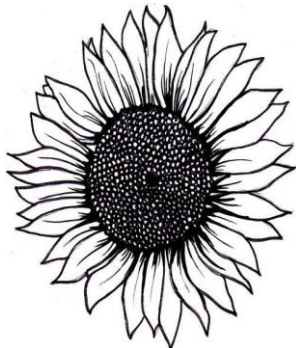

of Our Lord Church.

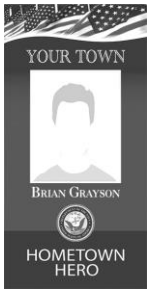


**BASKET RAFFLE FUNDRAISER TO

HOMETOWN HERO FLAGS in NANTICOKE: Do you want to remember your family member or Friend who served in the armed forces? The Hometown Hero Flags that you see honoring our Veterans along the city streets of Nanticoke are still available-they must be ordered in units of 10. Currently, the city has a request for 5 flags. When 5 more requests arrive, they will order and display additional flags. The cost per flag is \$200 and typically the flags will be displayed from Memorial Day to Labor Day for three years. You can also request to have a flag displayed in the Hanover Section of Nanticoke.
