SECOND SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

The Holy Apostle Jude, Brother of the Lord According to the Flesh

June 19, 2022

TROPAR: Though the stone was sealed by the Judeans, and soldiers guarded Your most pure body, You arose, O Savior, on the third day, and gave life to the world. And so the heavenly powers cried out to You, O Giver of Life: Glory to Your resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Your kingdom! Glory to Your saving plan, O only Lover of mankind.

TROPAR: As we know you to be Christ's relative and a steadfast martyr, O Jude, we praise you with sacred hymns. You trampled on error and kept the faith. And so on this day as we feast your memory through your prayers, O apostle, we receive release from our sins. **Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.**

KONDAK: You arose in glory from the tomb and with Yourself You raise the world. All the world acclaim You as God, and death has vanished. Adam exults, O Master, and Eve, redeemed from bondage now, cries out for joy: "You are the One, O Christ, Who offer resurrection to all."

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

KONDAK: O Jude, because of your solid mind you were shown to be a chosen disciple and firm pillar of the Church of Christ. You proclaimed to the nations His holy word teaching them to believe in the one God from Whom you received glory and the gift of healing to cure the ills of those who flee to you, O apostle, worthy of all praise.

PROKEIMON: Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, as we have hoped in You. verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you just; praise befits the righteous. Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, as we have hoped in You.

A Reading from the Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Romans 2:10-16:

Brethren, glory, honor and peace for everyone who does good: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. For God does not show favoritism. All who sin apart from the law will also perish apart from the law, and all who sin under the law will be judged by the law. For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God's sight, but it is those who obey the law who will be declared righteous. (Indeed, when Gentiles, who do not have the law, do by nature things required by the law, they are a law for themselves, even

though they do not have the law. They show that the requirements of the law are written on their hearts, their consciences also bearing witness, and their thoughts sometimes accusing them and at other times even defending them.) This will take place on the day when God judges people's secrets through Jesus Christ, as my gospel declares.

ALLELUIA: Alleluia (3). God gives me vindication and has subdued people under me. Alleluia (3) Making great the salvation of the king, and showing mercy to His anointed, to David, and to His posterity forever. Alleluia (3).

Gospel of Matthew 4:18-23/John 14:21-24



At that time Jesus was walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea (for they were fishers). And he said to them: Come you after me, and I will make you to be fishers of men. And they immediately leaving their nets, followed him. And going on from there, he saw other two brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets: and he called them. And they immediately left their nets and father and followed him. And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom: and healing all manner of sickness and every infirmity, among the people.

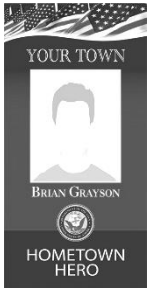
FATHER'S DAY: Happy Father's Day to All our Parish Dads- including our Parish Dad!

ASK FATHER A QUESTION? Father, I see many people posting online who are claiming that the Catholic Church teaches reincarnation and that the Catholic Church can support reincarnation. Some of these people are Hindu and they claim John the Baptist is Elijah reincarnated. Is Elijah reincarnated as John the Baptist and does the Catholic Church teach reincarnation? How can God do this? The

Catholic Church does not teach or promote in any way reincarnation. Reincarnation is that you come back as a different being then you are now-either of the same species or a different species.

If you search the church history, you will find that the prophet Elijah is the only person who lived and did not die. Many Protestants who misread the scriptures claim Enoch did not die either, because in the Old Testament you read, "God took him" which is a euphemism or a phrase that indicates that he died. Elijah was taken from the earth up to heaven-body and soul-by a chariot driven by an angel. The chariot was as brilliant as the sun, as witnessed by, Elisha, the student of Elijah. (2nd Book of KINGS 2:11) God can do anything, nothing is impossible for God. The prophecies following Elijah being taken to heaven by the angel, told that he would come again prior to the Messiah's birth. Jesus tells us John the Baptist was the second coming of Elijah, one and the same being that was taken to heaven. He is not reincarnated- a second person. **He IS Elijah, hence the second coming of Elijah.**

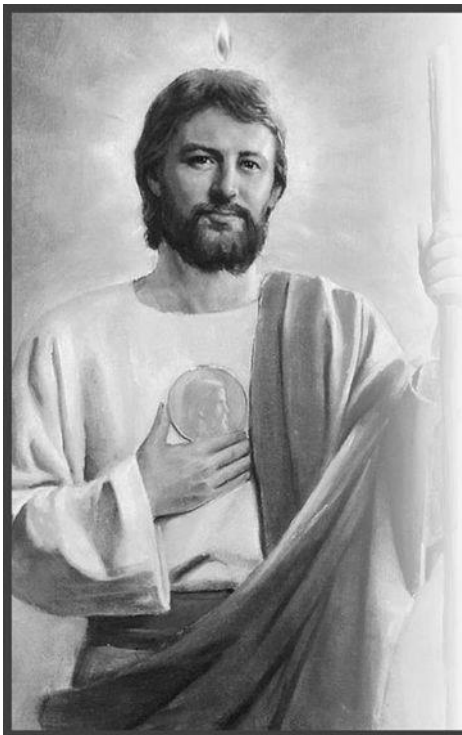
