A Reading of the First Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians (1:10-18):

I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no schisms among you; but that you be perfect in the same mind, and in the same judgment. For it has been told unto me, my brethren, of you, by them that are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you. Now this I say, that every one of you says, 'I indeed am of Paul'; and 'I am of Apollo'; and 'I am of Cephas'; and 'I of Christ'. Is Christ divided? Was Paul then crucified for you? or were you baptized in the name of Paul? I give God thanks, that I baptized none of you but Crispus and Caius; lest any should say that you were baptized in my name. And I baptized also the household of Stephanus; besides, I know not whether I baptized any other. For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not in wisdom of speech, lest the cross of Christ should be made void. For the word of the cross, to them indeed that perish, is foolishness; but to them that are saved, that is, to us, it is the power of God.

ALLELUIA: Alleluia (3). It is good to give praise to the Lord; and to sing to Your name, O Most High. Alleluia (3). To announce Your mercy in the morning, and Your truth every night. : Alleluia(3).

Gospel of Matthew 14:14-22

At that time when Jesus saw a large crowd, out of compassion for them he cured their sick. Now, when it was evening, his disciples came to him, saying, "This is a desert place and the hour is already late; send the crowds away, so that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food." But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away; you yourselves give them some food." They answered him, "We have here only five loaves and two fishes." He said to them, "Bring them here to me." And when he had ordered the crowd to recline on the grass, he took the five loaves and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to his disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And all ate and were satisfied; and they gathered up what was left over, twelve baskets full of fragments. Now the number of those who had eaten was five thousand men, without counting women and children. And immediately afterwards he made his disciples get into the boat and cross ahead of him, while he dismissed the crowd.

ASK FATHER A QUESTION? Can you help me with this, if the Saints are Human (it takes 50 years after death to become a Saint), how is it we can pray to the Saints and they acknowledge our prayers?- submitted by L.Placek

PART 1 of 2 This was last week's question.

Part 2 of 2 After writing this question, many parishioners had a different response to the answer. Some parishioners asked, "Where does the soul go after death?" is there a place appointed to receive souls after death? One parishioner went so far as to quote our Sorokousty Service- "Blessed is the way on which you go, O soul, for a place of rest has been prepared for you." & "In Your abode, O Lord, where all Your saints repose, give rest also to soul of servant, for You alone love mankind." Other parishioners found this theological discussion complex and needed a simple answer.

There is no simple answer. Theology is complex. The space here in this bulletin is insufficient to deal with all of these complexities. What you read is about as short and simple as that answer could possibly be in the space provided. What each parishioner needs to do is study God and grow in love of Him more. In other words, put in your own and effort and work and do your own work. If some ideas are not understood, formulate a question about what you don't understand and submit it for this column. Questions can be submitted anonymously by dropping them in the collection basket. Also, I suggest coming to the adult discussion group that we have Saturday evenings in Fall. Because topics like this need to be handled in discussion.

There are many questions on the soul that are difficult to answer, for example, "How is the soul attached to the body?" "Is the soul a substance?" "Is the soul composed of matter and form?"

I attempted to answer the question that was submitted in this forum, partly because I thought other parishioners might have similar questions. This column is meant to address simple to complex issues as best as it can and to inspire a wide variety of people.

All you need to do is to submit a question. Be inspired to pray and think about God and church in your daily life, try to become closer to God.
